2013 Chip Seal Program

In summer 2013, a stop-gap chip-seal treatment program will be applied to selected streets, to prolong their serviceability and retard further deterioration of their current conditions. The selected streets are:

This work will be done in two distinct phases:

1) Filling potholes and placing a layer of "skin patch" pavement over major depressions in the road, followed by

2) A chip seal treatment, where a mat of rubberized liquid asphalt and half-inch rock chips will be applied to the entire road surface.

The treatment is intended to fill the existing cracks in the street and provide a new wearing surface, thereby preserving the existing condition of the road until such time when it can be reconstructed. This is not a resurfacing of the road, and the finished surface will have a rough texture and may have a salt-and-pepper appearance. Existing dips and undulations in the driving surface will likely remain after the treatment.

On the day of the chip seal work, the street will be closed to traffic and on street parking will be prohibited from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. In order for the contractor to sweep excess loose rocks after placement, cars should park off the chip-sealed streets for two days following the placement of the chip seal.

Specific dates for the various phases of work to be done on these streets will be available at a later time. In addition, signs will be placed at the entrance to the streets indicating the dates for this work.
