Springhill Valley Trail

The Springhill Valley Trail passes near your residence and provides easy access to the incredible world of nature which we, in Lafayette, have the good fortune to have as our cohabitant. Nearby are beautiful valleys, peaceful knolls, vistas and canopied pathways, all of which beckon your company and offer a treasure chest of relaxation and inspiration.

This 'feeder' trail has been designed and constructed by the East Bay Conservation Corps for neighborhood use to provide easy access to the scenic Lafayette Ridge Trail and Briones Regional Park. We encourage you, your family and friends to enjoy your neighborhood trail and to explore the areas beyond by hiking the regional network of trails; all of which are available to you without the use of a car.

The entrance from Springhill Valley is at the intersection of Goyak Drive and Leslyn Drive. From there the trail proceeds up Leslyn Drive 0.5 mile, where the newly constructed portion leaves the asphalt road and follows the beautiful hillside contours beneath the oaks, maples and bay laurels as it rises to meet the Lafayette Ridge Trail (EBRPD).

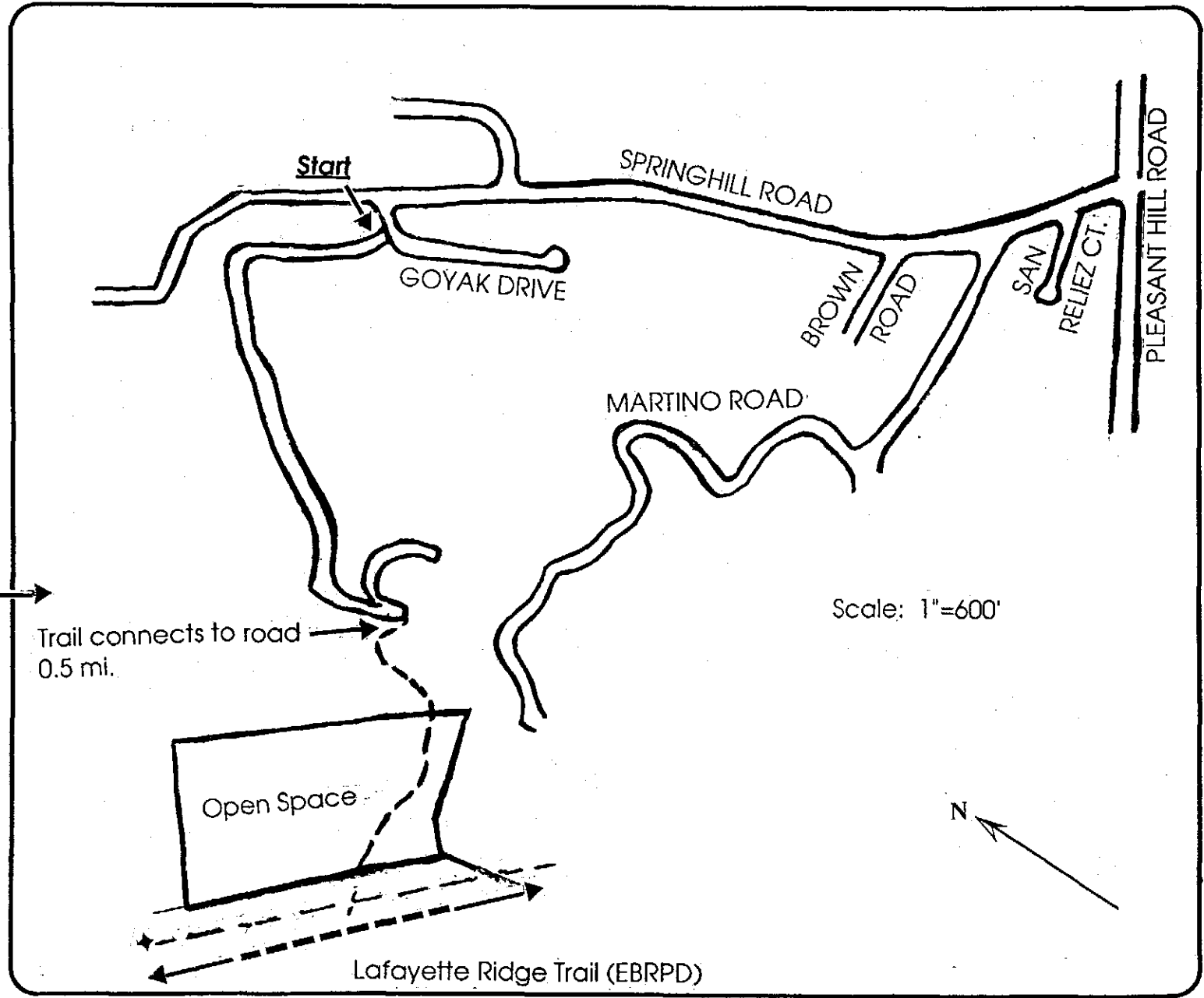
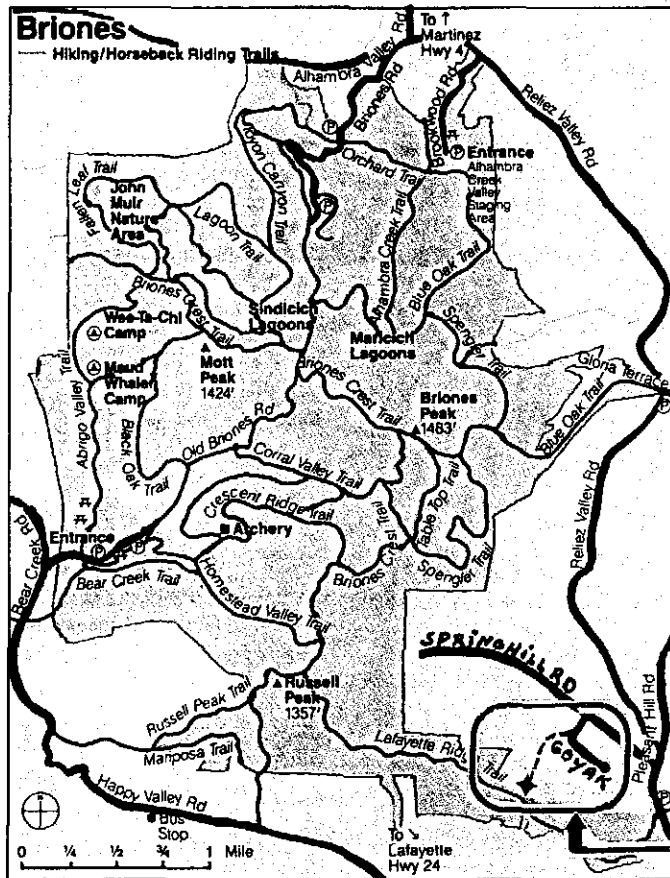
Lafayette Trail Use Guidelines

Neighborhood trails are for use by hikers and walkers of any age free of charge. Horseback riding is allowed where posted, and dogs are welcome on a leash. Radios, record players, amplifiers and similar sound creating devices may not be used in a way which disturbs the peace and comfort of the neighborhood or trail users. Use and/or transport of alcoholic beverages, firearms, weapons, bicycles and motorized vehicles is prohibited on the trails.

Wear appropriate walking or hiking shoes and warm clothing at times of lower temperature.

Trails are open for use from dawn to dusk.
