- A. City desires to retain the services of Contractor to provide services for Construction of **2013 Surface Seal Project, Project No. 014-9695**, including, but not limited to: mobilization; traffic control and construction signage; clearing and grubbing including tree trimming; traffic striping, marking and marker removal, removal and replacement of concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, and driveway; construction of asphalt concrete pavement repairs, crack seal, rubberized chip seal, slurry seal, microsurfacing, traffic stripes, markers, and markings; and all other work as shown on the plans and as described in the specifications to provide a complete project.
- B. Contractor has represented to City that it has the expertise, experience and qualifications to perform the services described in Paragraph A, above, and those services which are more fully described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the covenants and agreements set forth below, City and Contractor agree as follow:

- 1. <u>Contract Documents</u>. The contract documents for the aforesaid project shall consist of the Notice to Contractors, Bid Proposal, General Provisions, Technical Provisions, Special Provisions including appendices, Design Drawings, and all referenced specifications, details, standard drawings, and their appendices; together with this Contract Agreement and all required bonds, insurance certificates, permits, notices and affidavits; and also including any and all addenda or supplemental agreements clarifying, amending, or extending the work contemplated as may be required to insure its completion in an acceptable manner. All of the provisions of said contract documents are made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.
- 2. Services. Said compensation shall cover all expenses, losses, damages, and consequences arising out of the nature of the work during its progress or prior to its acceptance including those for well and faithfully completing the work and the whole thereof in the manner and time specified in the aforesaid contract documents; also including those arising from actions of the elements, unforeseen difficulties or obstructions encountered in the prosecution of the work, suspension or discontinuance of the work, and all other unknowns or risks of any description connected with the work.
- 3. <u>Employment by City</u>.
