NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE

Subject: Via Roble - Road Reconstruction, Project Number 014-9694

Dear Residents:

Bay Cities Paving & Grading will be starting the roadway reconstruction and paving phase of work next week on Via Roble. During this phase of work the street will be closed to vehicles, and parking on the shoulder of the road will be prohibited from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm. If you wish to have access to your vehicle during the road closure hours you may park on surrounding streets in any legal parking space and walk to and from your property. Please note that emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times.

The contractor's schedule calls for the following Road Closure dates on Via Roble (the section of Via Roble between the two Via Baja intersections):

- Thursday, August 8th & Friday, August 9th:
- Contractor will be pulverizing the roadway Monday, August 12th & Tuesday, August 13th: Contractor will be grading the roadway
- Wednesday, August 14th through Friday, August 16th: Contractor will be cement treating the roadway
- Monday, August 19th & Tuesday, August 20th: Contractor will be paving the roadway

Changes in the closure dates will be posted on or near the project information sign at the entrance to your street. In addition, weekly updates for the project schedule will be posted on the City's web site at http://www.ci.lafayette.ca.us (select "Public Works & Construction" under the quick links; then select "Capital Improvements Projects"; then select the 2013 Road & Drain Project, Project Number 014-9694; and lastly select Weekly Project Update).

The City and the contractor are anxious to complete this project with minimum delay and inconvenience to you. While the work is in progress, please lend us your cooperation and extra patience and be alert to equipment, workers, and traffic
