The Crosses: A Protest Against Forgetting

The exhibition consists of digital prints of Daguerreotype images by noted photographer Binh Danh. Over several years, Danh documented THE CROSSES in Lafayette. These images preserve moments in the history of the memorial. Danh's work investigates his Vietnamese heritage and our collective memory of war. Danh's newest body of work focuses on the Daguerreotype process with subjects ranging from American Civil War battlefields to national parks. His work is included in museum exhibitions and collections across the country. Danh is currently on the faculty of Arizona State University and is represented by the Haines Gallery in San Francisco. The exhibit runs from January 13 to March 21, 2014. The library gallery is free and open most Monday evenings from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and during public events in the Community Hall.
