Living in that rich wild land gave me an intense appreciation for the vivid details of nature where I spent most of my available time out of doors. In this current series of pen and ink drawings I have blended in scriptural references that became an integral part of and unique to each drawing. These present unique biblical themes that the viewer can determine and consider.
