Tuition for the two-day training is covered by the Bay Area Regional Energy Network, and is offered at no cost to participants. Participants may purchase a copy of the Building Science Principles reference guide (\$75 hardcopy or \$50 electronic). In order to earn the Building Performance Institute's Building Science Principles certificate, participants must pay for and take an exam (with trainers for \$75 or on your own for \$99). This training is for general and trade contractors that specialize in multifamily (5+ unit) buildings. Class size is restricted to 25 participants, and will initially be limited to 2 participants per company. Others will be placed on a waitlist.
