





New Manzanita Building Under Construction This Fall



Since 1984, when the City purchased a dilapidated school for the purpose of turning it into a much needed community center, a variety of facility improvements have occurred. During this 30 year time period one key facility has had to wait its turn—the Manzanita Building.

As part of the City's most recent budget cycle, it became evident that a new structure was needed to replace a tired, outdated building. The new building will be

up to code, energy efficient, have a larger floor plan, great inside/outside views, a new patio and adjacent restrooms. All these new features will greatly improve overall program flexibility at the Center and offer an all-inclusive space for public events.

The new Manzanita Building is being funded with Park Facility Improvement Fees and, once completed, will continue to provide a revenue source from the many classes, camps and events that will use the new space.

During construction, which is estimated to occur from September 2014 through Spring 2015, the Community Center will remain open. The construction area will be cordoned off so the public can navigate safely around the Center.

- All Supply/Lab Fees are payable directly to instructors at first class.
