

Olympic Boulevard and Reliez Station Road Corridor (Pleasant Hill Road - Glenside Drive N.) Traffic Study Community Engagement Process



BACKGROUND

The City of Lafayette is conducting a traffic study along the Olympic Boulevard and Reliez Station Road Corridor between Pleasant Hill Road and Glenside Drive (North). Engaging the public, we hope to identify traffic problems and concerns along the corridor and explore solution options to address them.

The robust participation from the community to date has gone a long way to identify a wide range of concerns to users of and residents along the corridor. Public input has also guided the development of solution alternatives targeting those concerns.

UPDATE

Draft final improvement recommendations by the Consultant will be presented to the Circulation Commission at a public meeting on Monday, May 4, held in the Arts & Science Discovery Center at the Lafayette Library and Learning Center. The recommendations are based on the feedback received from the public engagement process to date and the Circulation Commission briefing in March.

The Commission will be asked to support the consultant recommendations to the City Council for final approval later this month. Upon final approval, the project will move into the implementation phase, starting with detailed engineering and design. Additional public meetings will be held to present detailed design drawings and solicit feedback on them.
