CAMP IS OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION

The Manzanita room at the Lafayette Community Center has served as home to Camp Awesome for many years. Currently the new LARGER Manzanita room with attached restrooms and drinking fountains is under construction. 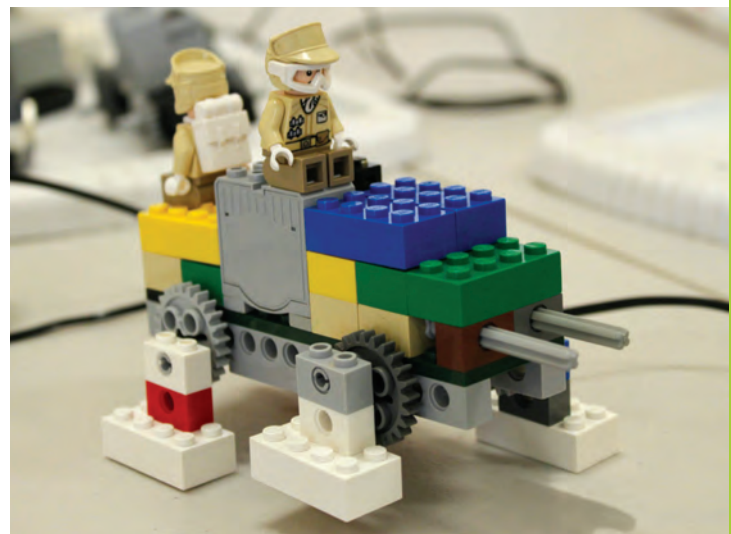

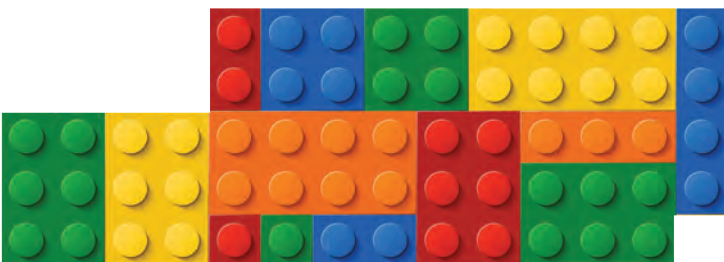

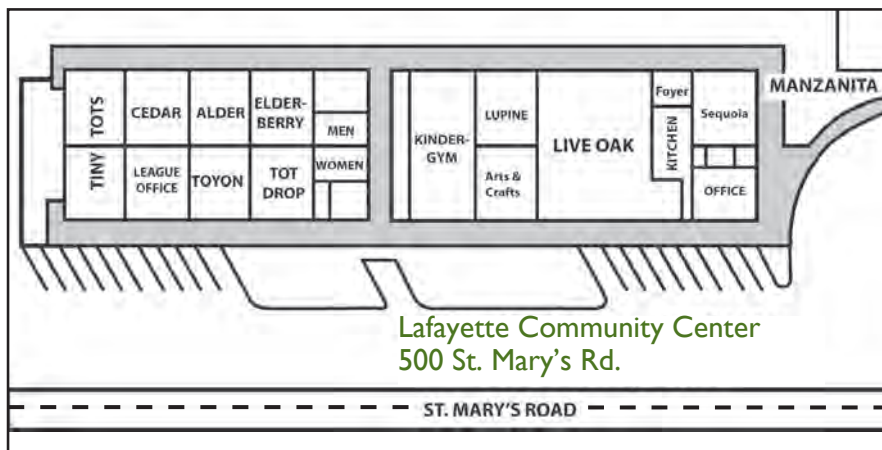
