We will take BART to 19th Street in Oakland. This urban hike will take us around Lake Merritt, up stairways (including the historic Cleveland Cascade) and around the Morcom Rose Garden. Bring snacks, water, layered clothing, good walking shoes, sun protection and money for lunch and to contribute toward gas, bridge tolls and parking (\$5). We form carpools.

Visit the Anderson collection art gallery that just opened this year at Stanford University. After we have lunch at a cafe on campus, or bring your own, we will take a hike passing the Stanford dish in the hills west of and above Stanford University with views to the east bay hills.
