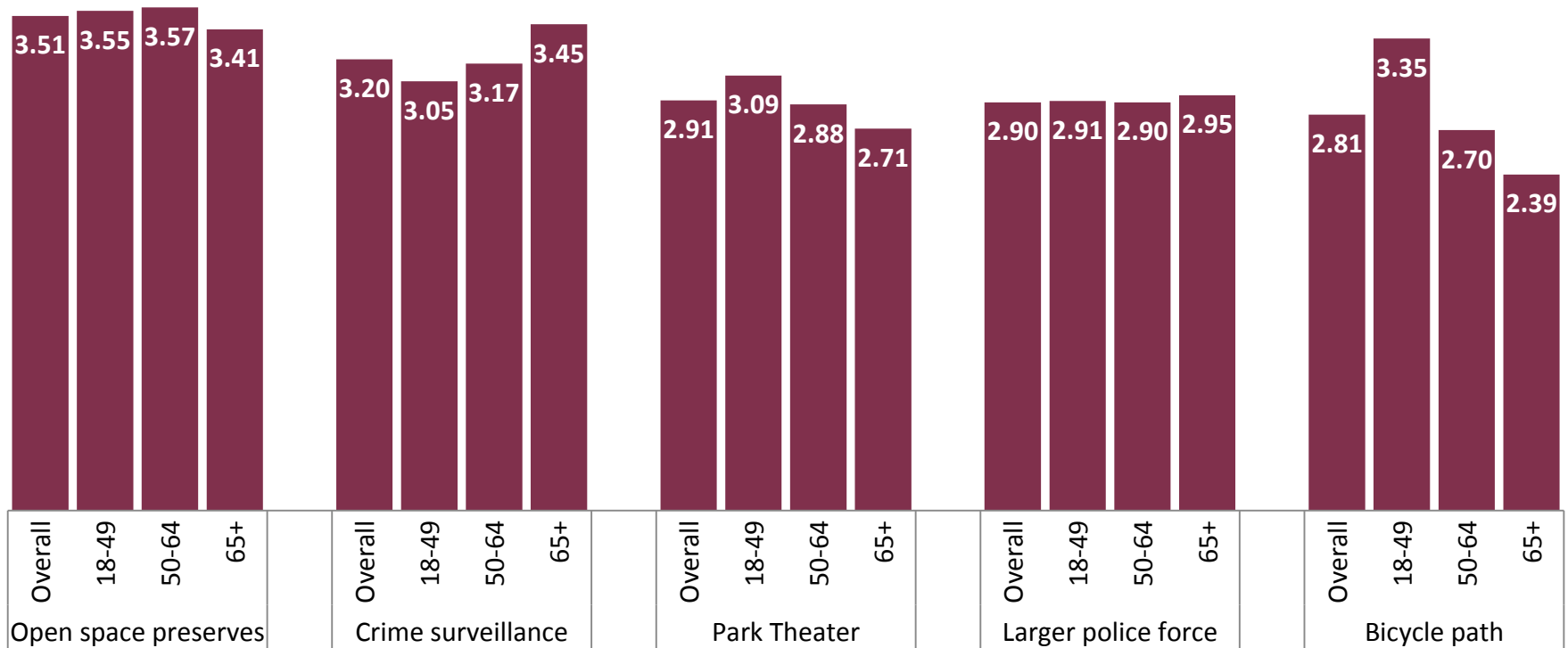

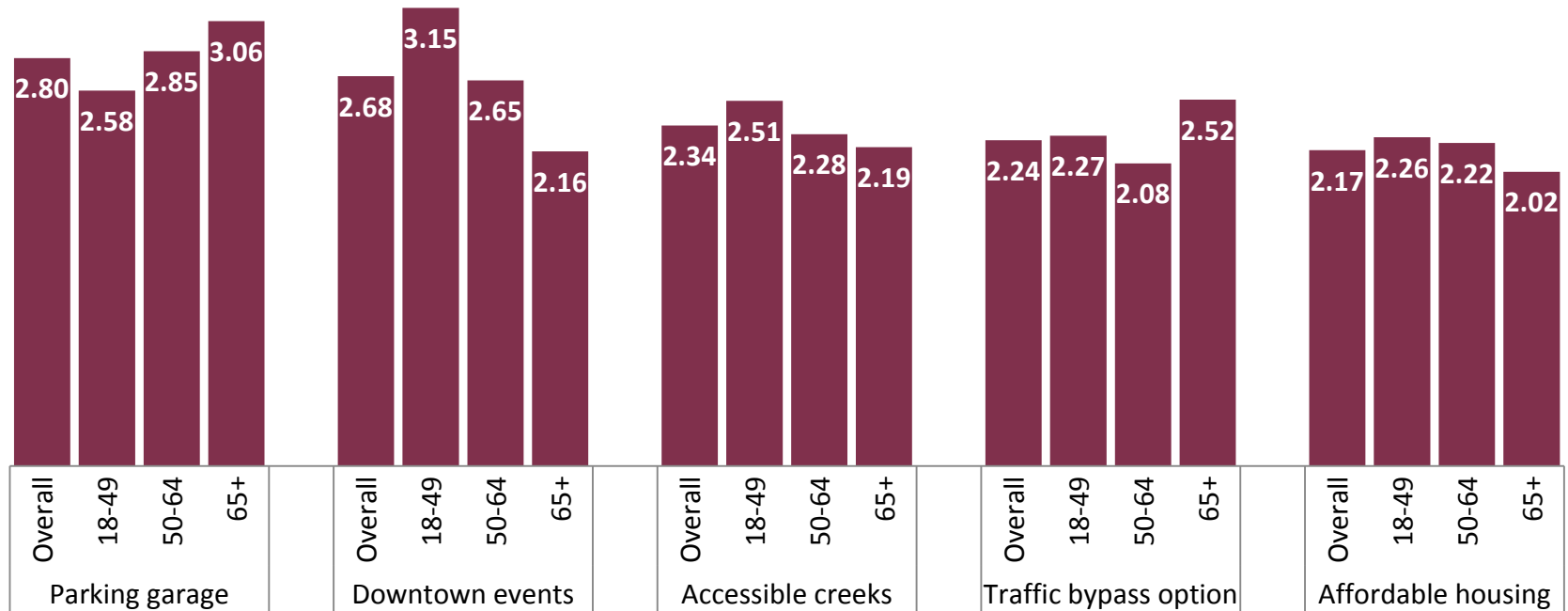

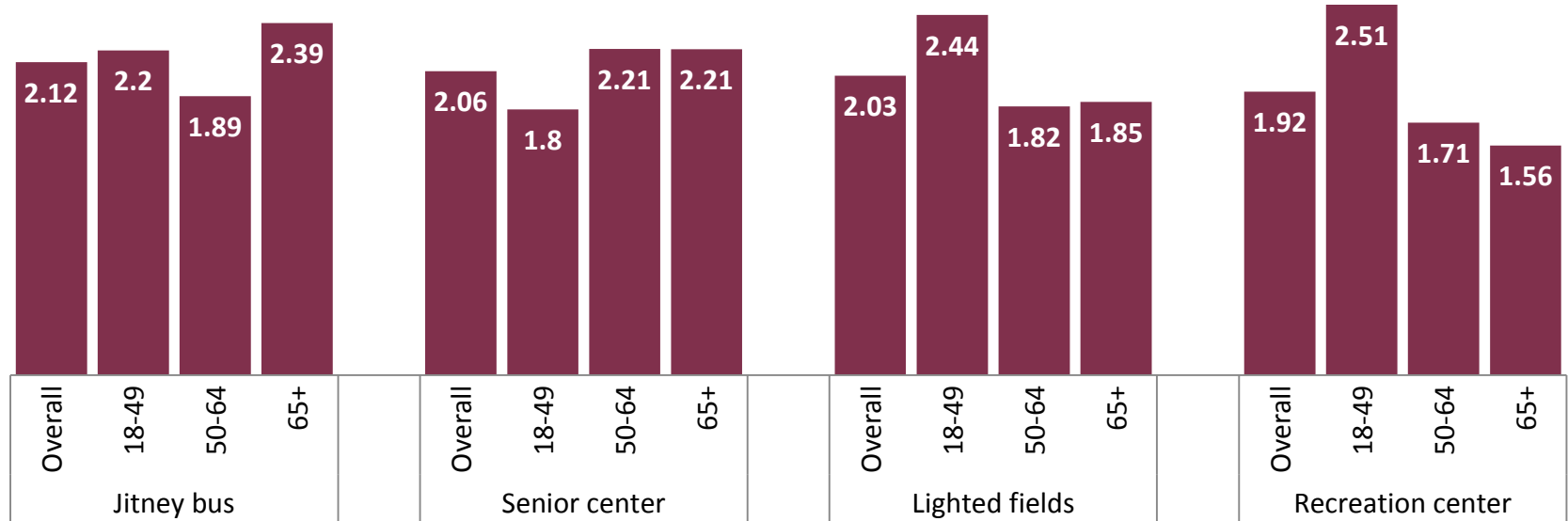

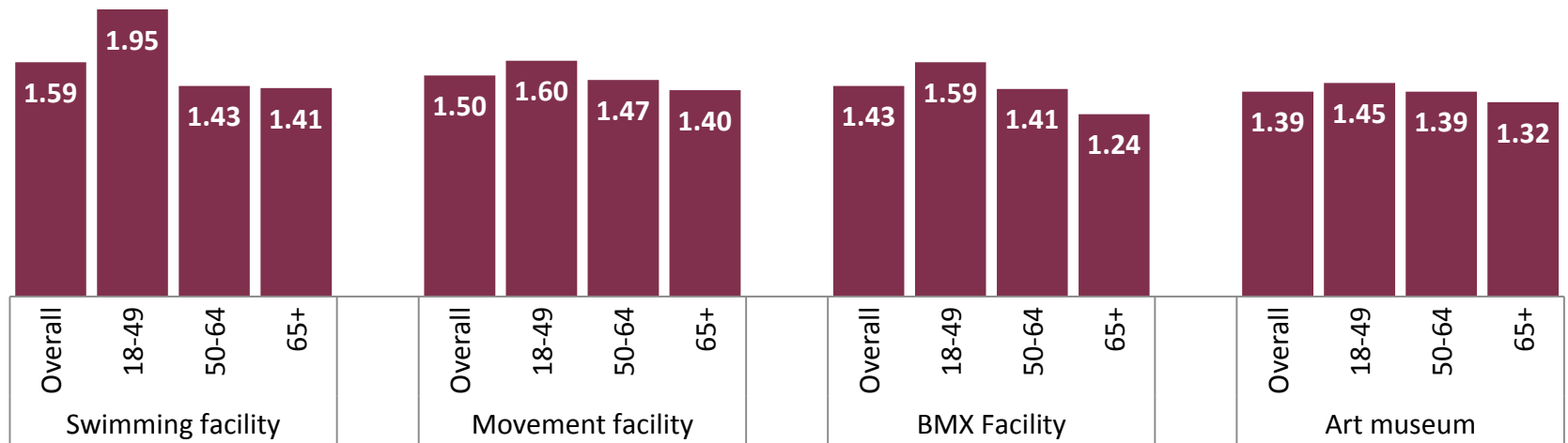

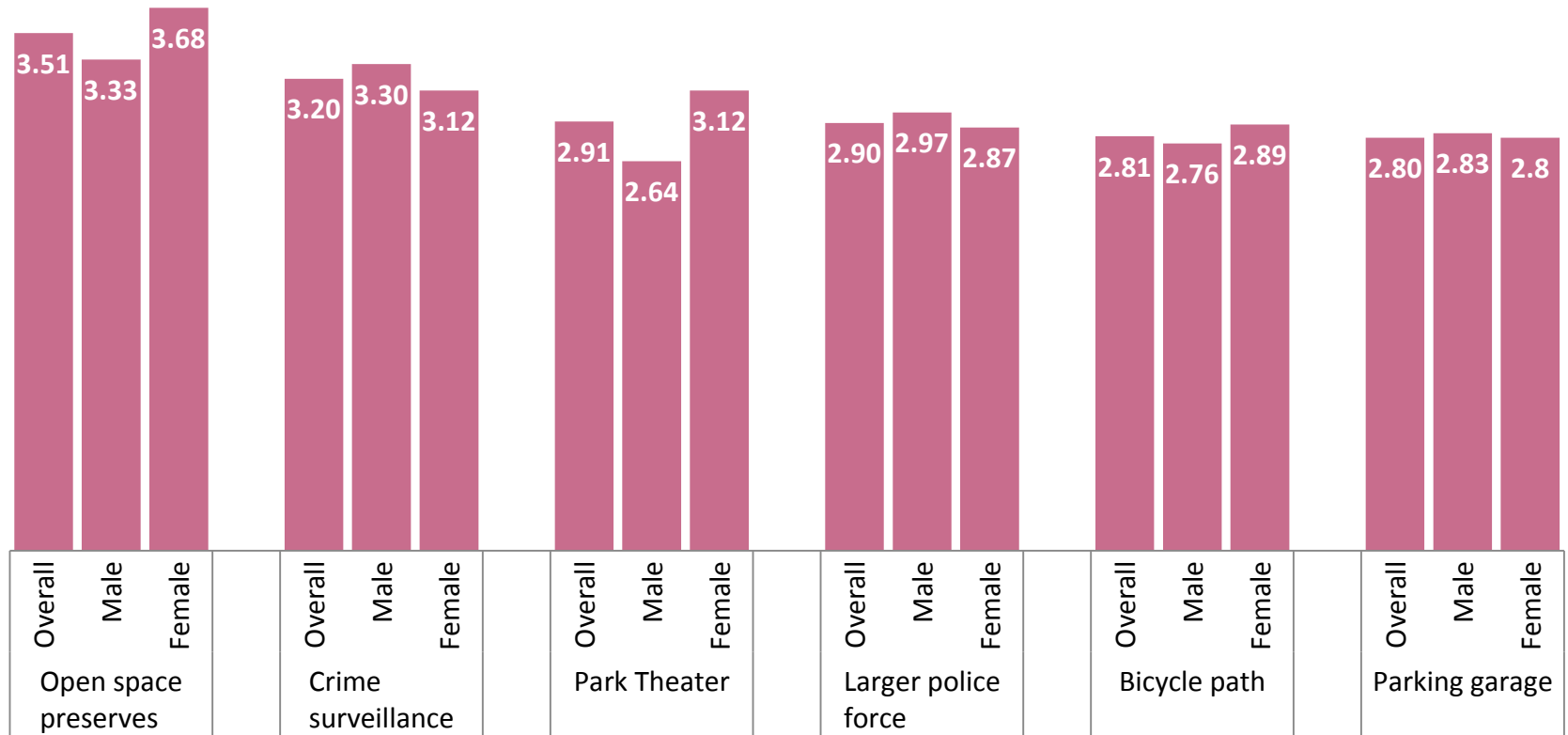

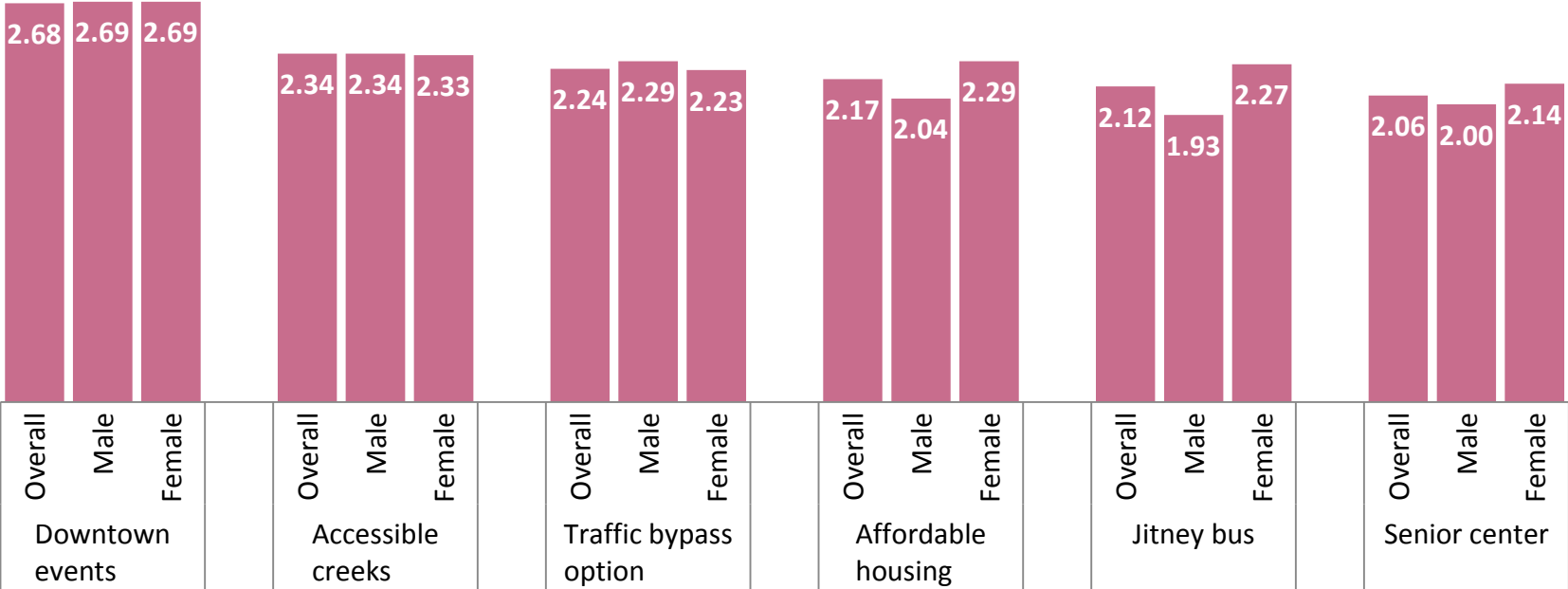

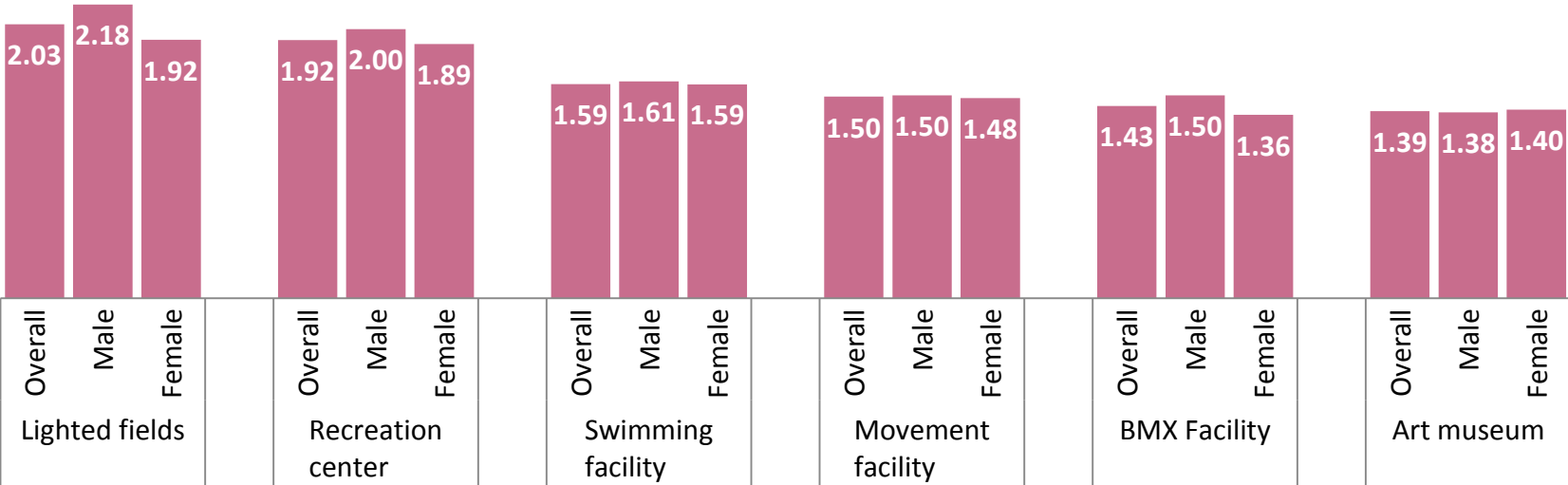

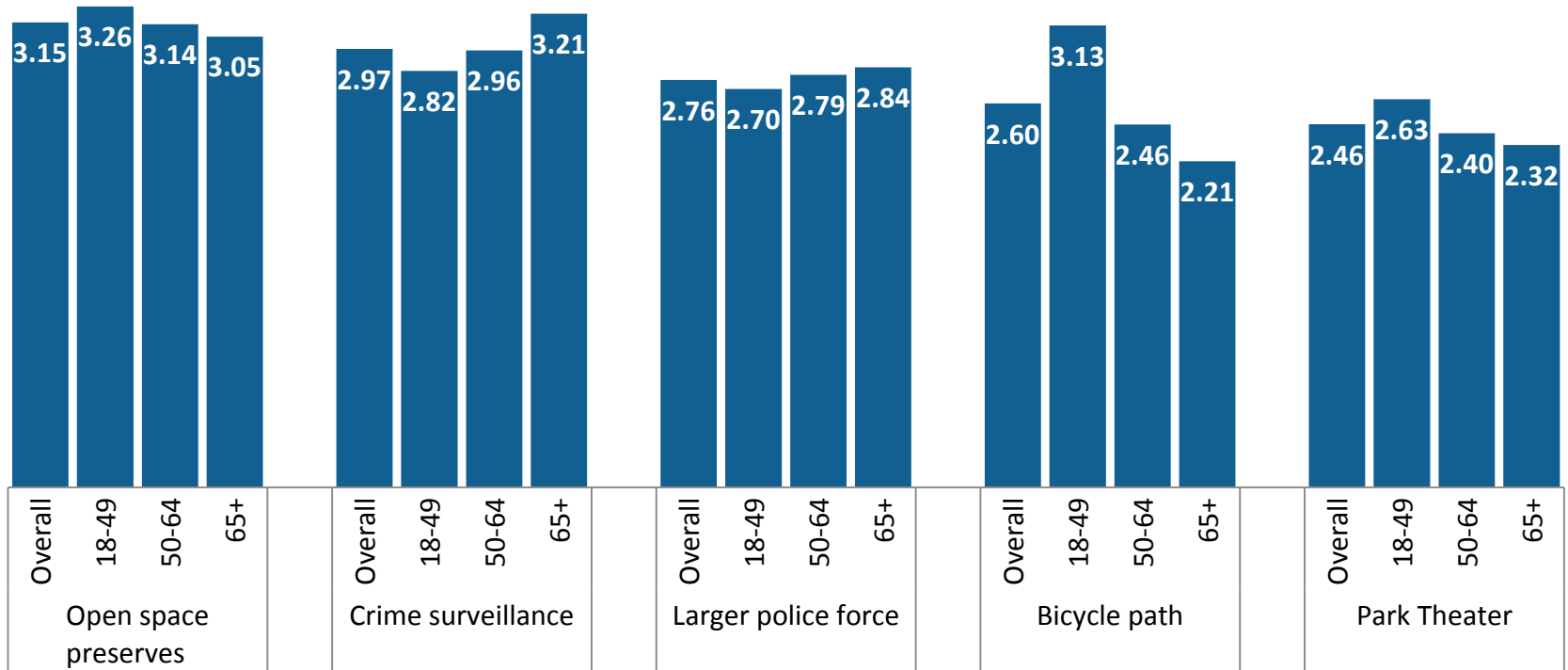

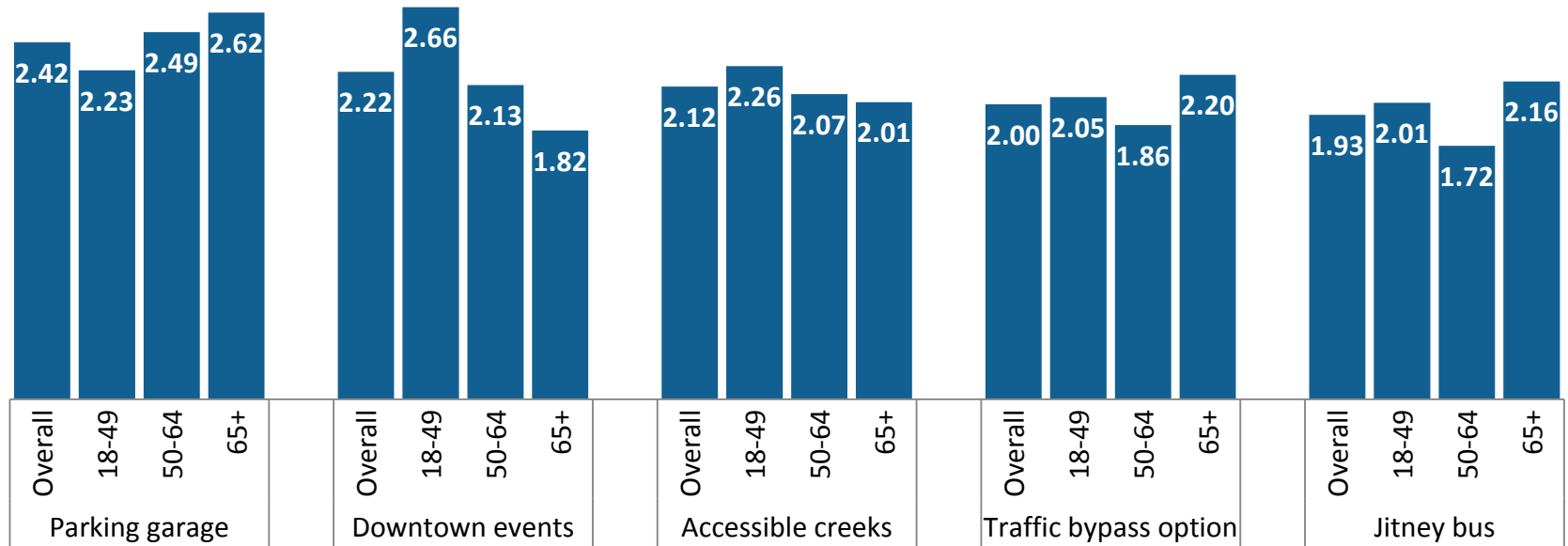

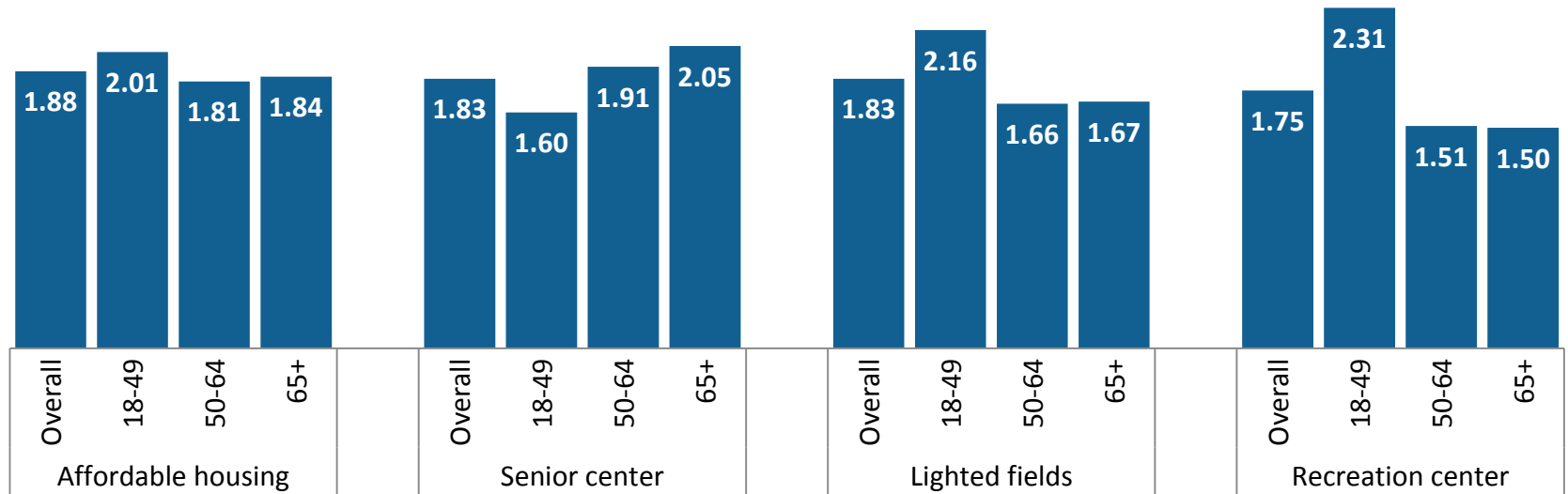

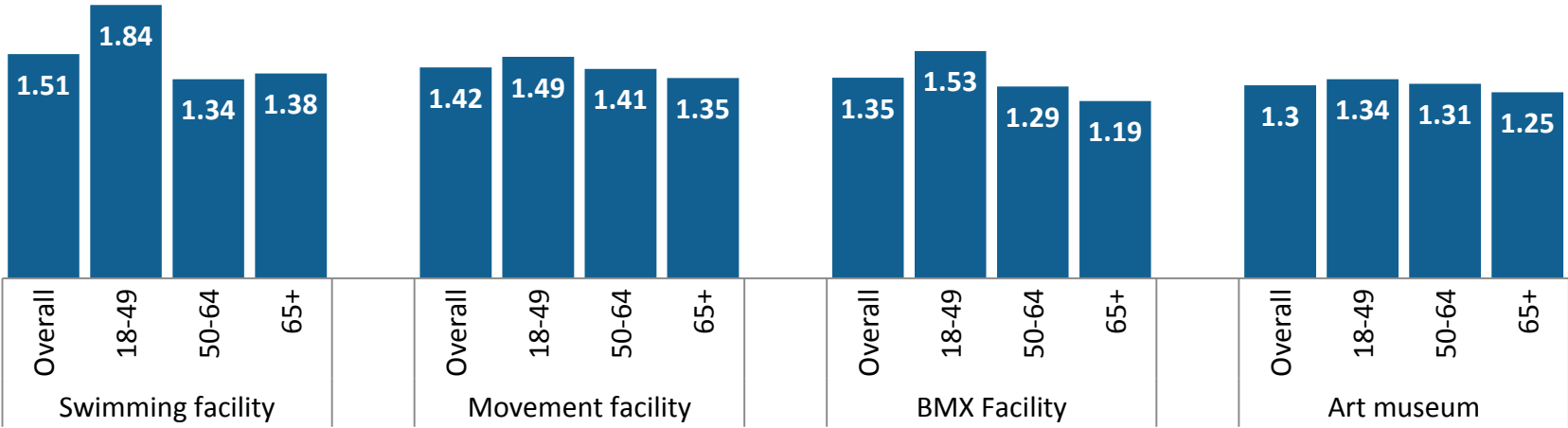

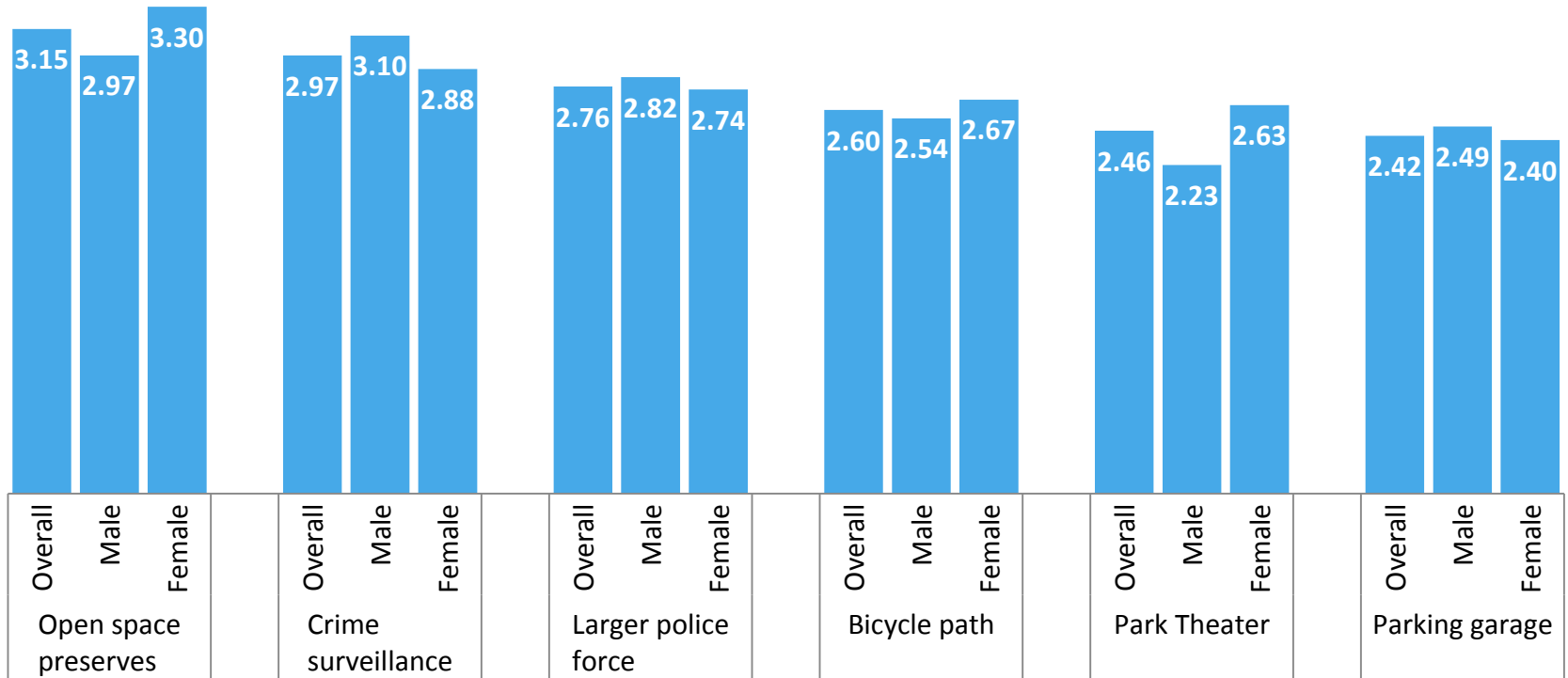

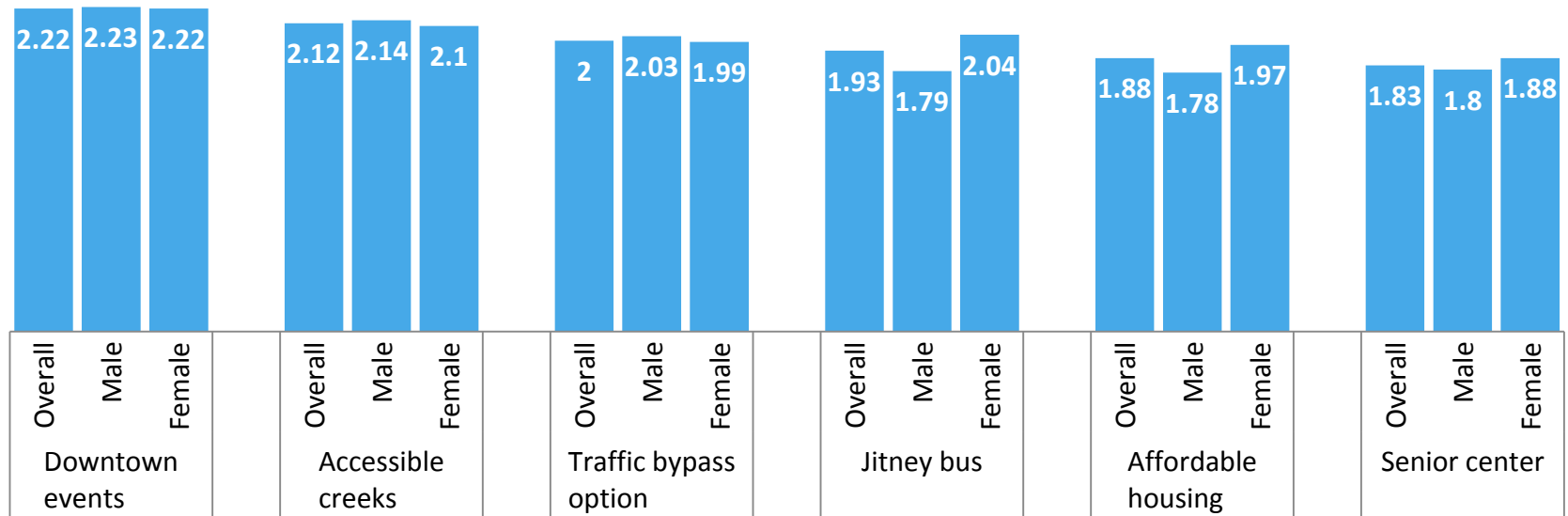


# Pay Willingness by Gender



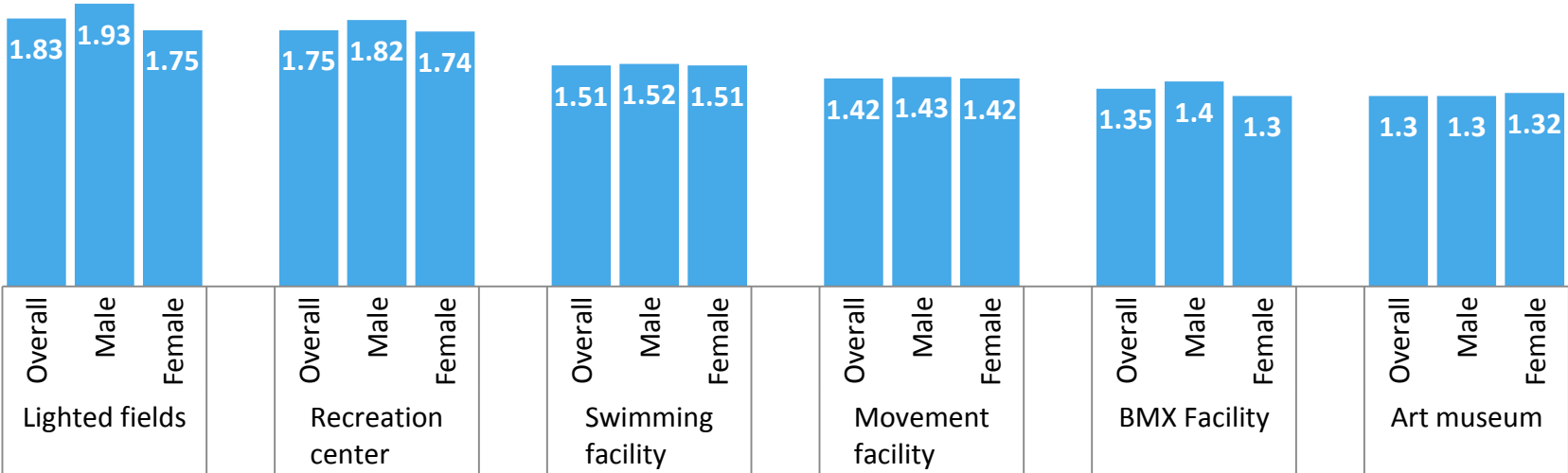

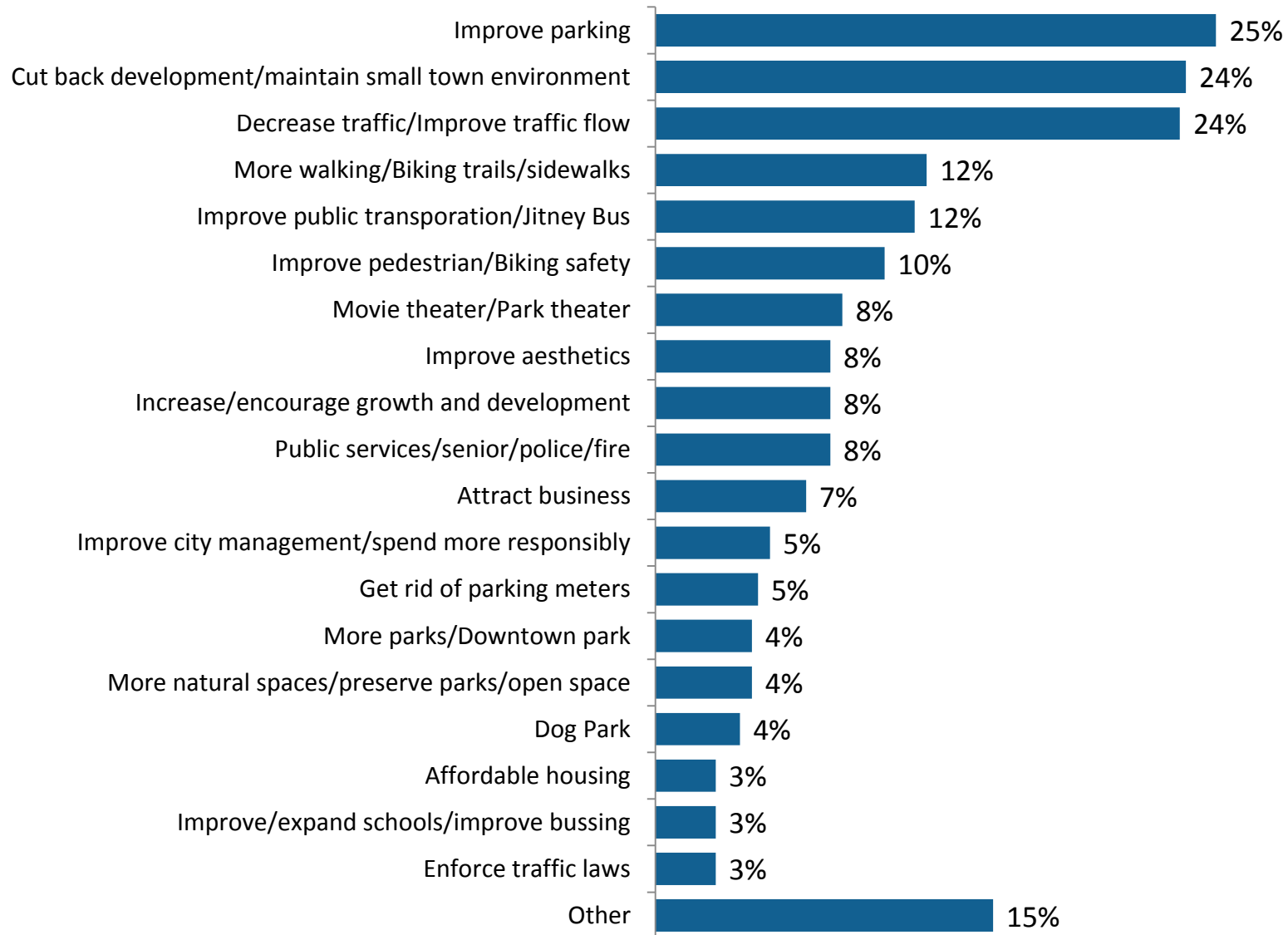

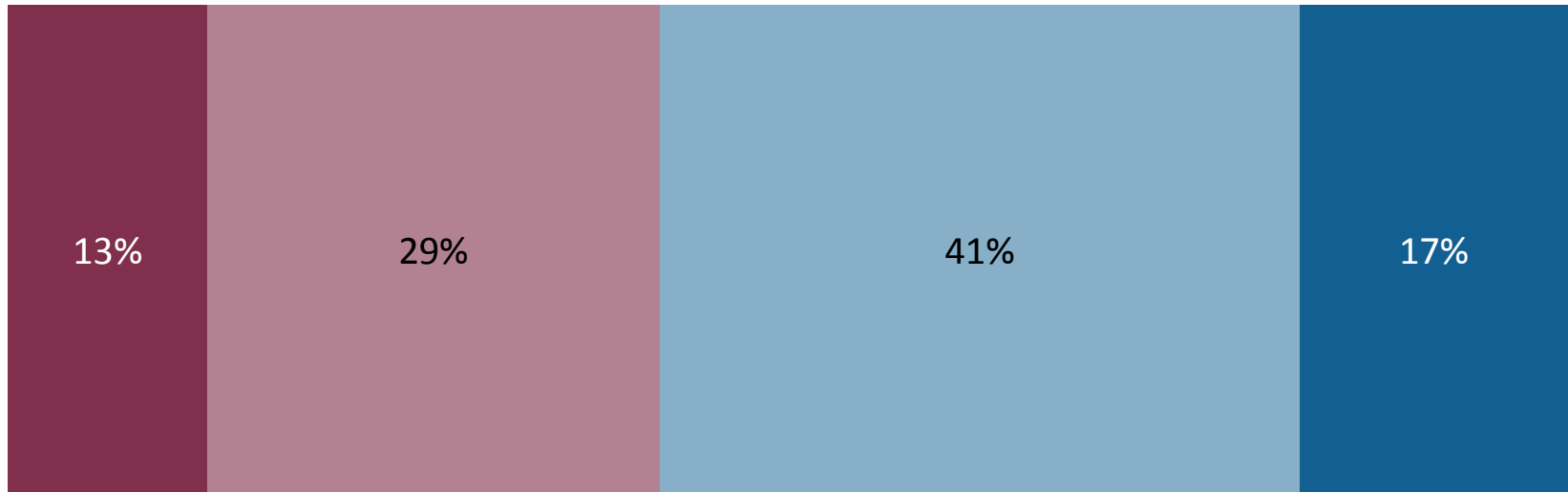
