

Existing Conditions and Key Issues

Physical

- Deteriorated paving
- Sidewalk cracking and uplift

Operational


- Substandard parking layout
- Inadequate number of ADA stalls
- Confusing station entry / poor wayfinding
- Poor circulation
- Congested Intermodal Area (Kiss & Ride and Bus zone)
- Underutilized entry/exit to Happy Valley Road

Environmental

- Unfiltered storm-water runoff
- Inadequate trash enclosure



Existing Poor Internal Circulation





What will the project accomplish?

- Repair and Rehabilitation
 - Replace paving
 - ADA compliance
 - Improved wayfinding/signage
- Sustainability
 - Improve quality of storm water entering the Happy Valley Creek Watershed
 - LED lighting
 - Reduce heat island
 - Increase trees
 - Improve landscape/irrigation

- Functionality
 - Enhanced Kiss&Ride
 - Enhanced pedestrian access
 - Enhanced bus zone
 - Two-way drive aisles
 - Improve circuclation
 - Increase motorcycle parking
 - Added speed table



When will Construction Start? Late April/Early May


What will be the duration? 8 months


What will be impacts to Parking?
