#### The Ideal Candidate

The City seeks a high energy professional who is self-motivated, creative, tactful and detail-oriented. The candidate should have the equivalent of an Associate's degree with coursework in urban planning, economics, business or public administration, or a related field and at least one year of professional experience in planning, zoning and related community development activities. All candidates must have the ability to work some evening hours to attend Council and Commission meetings and must have a valid California drivers license.

Exceptional analytical and communication skills and the ability to write well and persuasively are required.

### **Compensation & Benefits**

The salary range for the position is \$57,792 - \$76,019. Lafayette also provides an attractive benefits package that includes:

- A 401-A retirement plan with City-paid monthly contributions of 10% of salary with the option of a 5% match as well as City-paid social security contributions. Lafayette does not participate in PERS.
- City-subsidized health and dental insurance up to 95% as well as generous in-lieu payments for those that opt out of health and dental insurance.
- City-paid life insurance, disability insurance and employee assistance program.
- Commuter benefits including 50% subsidy of BART tickets for employees who use BART to get to work.
- 12 paid holidays and up to 20 days of annual vacation, depending on tenure.
