Appeal of W. C. Nuoffer, et al. from Action of Board of Appeals on Application No. 82-67 for Land Use Permit. Lafayette Area. Independent Construction Co. and A. G. Lagiss. Applicants.

This being the time fixed for decision on the appeal of W. C. Nuoffer, et al. from the action of the Board of Appeals in denying his appeal and granting with conditions the application of Independent Construction Co. and A. G. Lagies (82-67) to establish a quarry in the Lafayette area, and this Board having thoroughly discussed the matter and being fully advised in the premises:

Supervisor J. E. Moriarty moved that the appeal be denied and the permit granted with the following conditions:

- 1. The excavation slopes to be decreased to 1/34:1 and the top five (5) feet of the slopes to be rounded to a five horizontal to one wartical (5:1). No angular cuts and fills shall be established. All edges shall be rounded, tapered or feathered.
- 2. The top excavation be a minimum of ten (10) feet from the toe of the proposed State of California fill for Deer Hill Road Extension, which shall be used as a planting area.
- 3. The proposed level area indicated on the plan be split into two separate pads of approximate equal size at a thirty (30) foot difference in elevation. This will decrease the required excavation below Deer Hill Road Extension and substantially reduce the effective height of the slope.
- 4. Slope benches be provided at the midpoint of the excavations exceeding twenty (20) feet in height. These benches will be used for slope drainage and planting purposes. If excavated slopes are decreased to two to one the benches may be eliminated.
- 5. In those areas requiring fill material, the fill shall be placed in accordance with the County Grading Ordinance.
- 6. Adequate dust control shall be maintained at all times, subject to the requirements of the County Health Department. Said control shall include the watering of all loaded trucks leaving the premises.
- 7. A planting program for erosion control and slope screening on all exposed slopes shall be submitted to the County Zoning Administrator for review and approval. The planting program shall commence as soon as excavation slopes are brought to final grade and shall continue until all quarry operations have terminated.

If at any time, the final grade as indicated on the plan and required by these conditions is not reached and the quarry operations have been terminated prior to December 31, 1970, the approved planting program shall be thereupon diligently pursued until certified as completed by the Zoning Administrator.

- 8. Hours of operation of equipment be limited to the following:
 - Earth moving equipment: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. a.
 - Hauling from the site: + 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. b.
 - Crusher operation: 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. No work other than maintenance of equipment shall take place on Sundays, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
 - On to Pleasant Hill Road.
- The County Grading Engineer shall review the quarry operations with the applicant every three months.
- . 10. Any overburden disposal areas and placement of the overburden material shall be subject to inspection and approval by the County Grading Engineer.
- 11. Access to the quarry site from Pleasant Hill Road shall be opposite Stanley Boulevard at the location of the proposed Deer Hill Extension (sketch prepared by and on file in the Public Works Department).
 - 12. No blasting shall be permitted on the premises.
- 13. The quarrying shall be conducted within the area indicated on the map submitted with the application.
- 14. All rock crushing equipment and other equipment used. in the quarry operation shall be nemoved from the premises within 60 days of the permit expiration date.
- 15. This permit shall be subject to review by the Planning Commission two years from date of approval.
- 16. This permit shall expire on December 31, 3970 and shall not be renewable.
 - 17. No material shall be brought to the site for processing.
- 18. Number of crushers at site shall be limited to one (1) unit (primary and secondary).
- 19. This permit is approved, as per the plot plan submitted to the Planning Department on March 14, 1967 identified as the "Lagiss Quarry Plan," subject to the above listed conditions.

The motion died from lick of a second.

The Board then having discussed the matter, with particular attention being given to Condition No. 16, on motion of Supervisor A. M. Dias, seconded by Supervisor T. J. Coll, IT IS BY THE BOARD ORDERED that said appeal is DENIED and said permit is GRANTED with the aforesaid conditions as submitted, with the exception of No. 16 which is amended to read "This permit shall expire on December 31, 1970."
