This packet contains an application form, park regulations and insurance requirements. Once the Parks, Trails & Recreation Department staff has received the applicable deposit, a completed application form and proof of insurance, a permit will be issued in your name.

# City of Lafayette Parks, Trails & Recreation Department Sports Fields Use Categories and Rental Fees

1. Established Seasonal Leagues with over 85% Lafayette Residency: Established, Lafayette baseball, softball and soccer leagues that use the fields for practices and games, mostly against Lafayette resident teams, over an established time period (generally a min. of 2.5 months). Groups in this category use all volunteer coaches and offer open enrollment (not invitational). Youth leagues with the highest number of Lafayette residents have scheduling priority over all other users. Must have over 85% Lafayette resident participation. A \$500 security deposit is required at the time of the reservation. All fees are due 30 days prior to first day of use.

Lafayette Baseball/Softball Leagues	\$8/hr/field
Lafayette Soccer Leagues	\$15/hr/field
Security Deposit (Fully refundable if no damages incurred)	\$500

2. Scheduled Organizations, Clubs, or Select Teams: Organizations or teams using the fields on a regularly scheduled basis, but not part of an established Lafayette league. Use would typically consist of a set schedule of weekly practice sessions and/or games and may be against non-Lafayette teams. A \$500 security deposit is required at the time of the reservation. All fees are due 30 days prior to first day of use.

Baseball/Softball	\$20/hr/field
Soccer/Lacrosse	\$25/hr/field
Security Deposit (Fully refundable if no damages incurred)	\$500

3. <u>Daily Camps, Clinics, & Tournaments</u>: Individuals or groups wishing to use the fields for tournaments, sports camps, player or coaches clinics. A non-refundable reservation deposit of \$50 is required to save the date. All fees are due 30 days prior to first day of use.

Baseball/Softball Camps/Clinics/ Tournaments	\$180/day
Soccer/Lacrosse Camps/Clinics/ Tournaments	\$220/day
Security Deposit (Fully refundable if no damages incurred)	\$500

4. <u>Hourly, Short Term</u>: Individuals or groups wishing to use the fields on a short term basis, i.e., for a few hours on a single day. Typical uses include company/family picnics, birthday parties and reunions. A non-refundable reservation deposit of \$50 or actual cost of use (whichever is less) is required to save the date. All fees are due 30 days prior to use.

#### **SPORTS-FIELD RULES**

In addition to the general park rules, users of the sports fields must comply with the following:

- 1. Use of sports fields is by permit only. Bring your permit with you in case you need to show others that you have reserved the fields.
- 2. Motor vehicle access, beyond the parking lot, is by permit only. If permission is granted, you must ensure the access gate is closed and locked during daily permitted use period.
- 3. No permanent marking of the fields is allowed. Only latex paint that disappears in a few weeks is acceptable. Herbicides, lime or any other product that injures the turf is expressly forbidden.
- 4. Adequate manpower must be provided to move equipment on/off the fields at the end of daily permitted use period.
- 5. Store all sorts equipment in designated locations after each rental period. Do not leave any equipment on or about the fields, they must be properly stored.
- 6. Lock knack boxes and batting cages after daily permitted use period. Label and lock goals after daily permitted use period.
- 7. Anchor goals onto turf in such a way that they cannot be tipped over.
- 8. Rake and replace base path material, pitcher's mound, practice mounds, pitcher and batter warm-up areas, bullpens and infield material (baseball leagues and practice teams).
- 9. Pick up and dispose of all litter and garbage immediately after daily permitted use period.
- 10. Install and maintain automatic pitching and other practice equipment (baseball leagues).
- 11. Immediately report any damage to fields, equipment or facilities, maintenance requests including irrigation, tree trimming or weed abatement to the Parks, Trails, & Recreation department office at 500 St. Mary's Road, (925)284-2232.

I have read and understand the above rules and I will make sure that <u>all members of my</u> <u>group/organization</u> are aware of the rules & abide by them. Failure to do so may result in the termination of any and all permits.

ALL REQUIREMENTS AND ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE LAFAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 11, CHAPTER 1, APPLY TO USE OF THE COMMUNITY PARK, TRAILS AND SPORTS FIELDS.

### City of Lafayette Parks, Trails & Recreation Department <u>Park Rules, Regulation & Restrictions</u>

- 1. The hours of the Park are from Dawn to Dusk.
- 2. Bounce houses or other inflatable play equipment are prohibited on any City Parks or Fields.
- 3. Use of the Sports Fields, Batting Cages, Petanque Courts, Boccee Court, Park Plaza and Group Picnic Area are by only if the organized group consisting of 5 or more persons. To apply for a permit call or visit the Parks Trails & Recreation Dept. Office located at the Lafayette Community Center, 500 Saint Mary's Road, or call 925-284-2232 and ask for an application to be mailed or emailed to you.
- 4. Alcohol and Smoking Strictly Prohibited.
- 5. Dogs & Horses are not permitted on the Sports Fields.
- 6. Dogs must be on a leash, no longer than 6 feet, and under the control of their owners at all times.
- 7. Dog waste and trash must be put in proper containers or carried out of the Park.
- 8. Motor vehicles, including motorbikes, are permitted in the parking area only. Vehicular access to the sports fields is by permission only at least 30 days in advance.
- 9. Fires are not permitted anywhere in the Park except in a barbecue unit approved by permit.
- 10. Any games or activities such as golf, model airplanes, rocketry, or anything likely to endanger property or sports field users are not permitted.
- 11. Plants and wildlife are protected by laws. It is a violation to hunt, harm, feed, frighten, kill, trap or chase a wild animal or remove the young, egg, or nest of any animal. No wood or plant gathering is permitted.
- 12. Firearms, hunting and fireworks are not permitted. It is a violation to possess or discharge any type of gun, including paint-guns and air-soft rifles.
- 13. It is a violation to write, mark, print or post signs on trees, buildings or public property. It is also a violation to cut, break, injure, deface, or disturb a building, sign, fence, bench, structure, apparatus, equipment or other property.
- 14. It is a violation to roller-skate, ride a bicycle, scooter or skateboard within the playground area, on grassy or planted areas, or leave them where a person may trip or be injured.
- 15. Bicycles are not permitted on designated nature trails.
- 16. Bicycles shall be operated in a safe manner especially when sharing trails with pedestrians. Bicycle speed on mixed-use trails shall not exceed 15 mph on straightaways and 5 mph around corners and on hills. Bicyclists shall call out to pedestrians so they have adequate time to move to the side.
- 17. Use of threatening, abusive, insulting or indecent language or gestures is prohibited.
- 18. Pick up all litter and debris from park grounds and deposit in trash or recycling containers.
- 19. Noise levels should not disturb neighbors and be within the city noise ordinance regulations.
- 20. Park users will be held financially responsible for any damage to City property.

All Requirements and enforcement provisions of the Lafayette Municipal Code, Title 11 Chapter 1, apply to use of City Parks, Trails and Sports Fields. Any person or persons who violate any of these regulations will be cited and/or fined.
