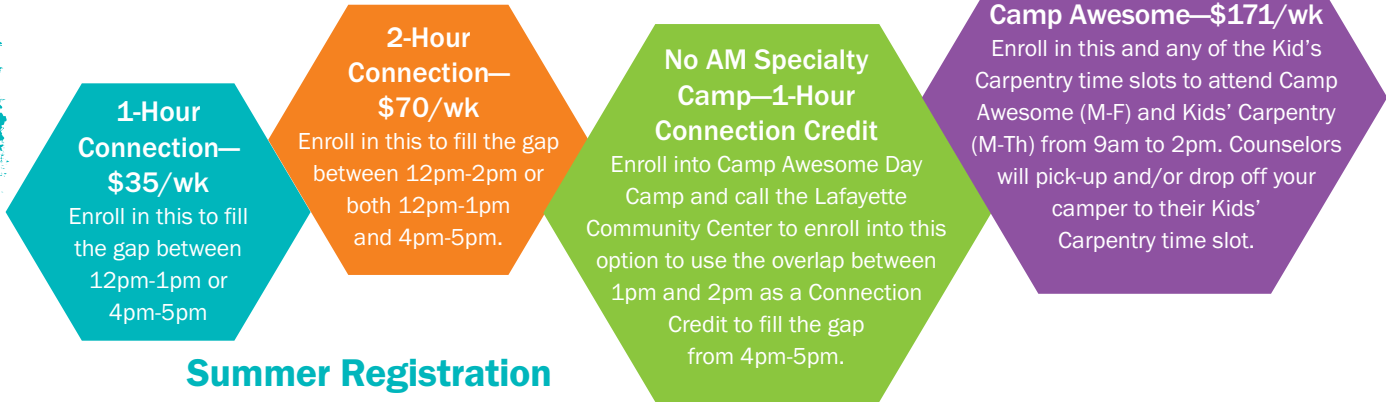


# Awesome Camp Connection

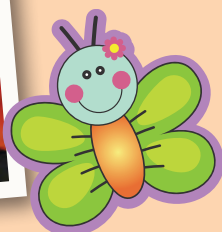

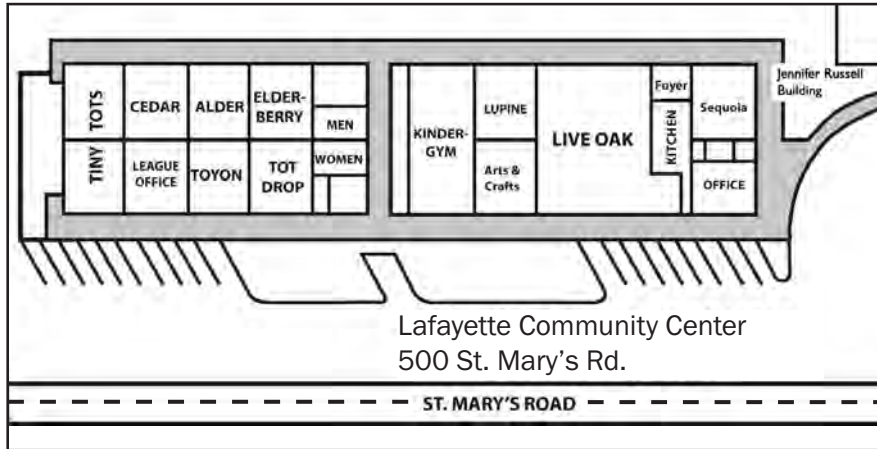
