ART EXHIBIT GUIDELINES

FOR THE LAFAYETTE LIBRARY AND LEARNING CENTER

Location: Adjacent to the Don Tatzin Community Hall, Lafayette Library and Learning Center, 3491 Mt. Diablo Blvd. Lafayette, CA 94549

Gallery Hours: The gallery is open to the public during public events occurring in the Community Hall.

Guidelines:

- Absolutely no adhesive may be used on walls.
- All artworks must be ready to hang, meaning each work must have a wire attached to its back
- Artist statement and artwork information (name of artist, title of work, media, year, dimensions) will be listed in a hanging frame at hall entrance.
- Artwork will hang from existing gallery SS hook cable system. See pictures below.



Spaces:

1. North Wall Space 1 (from entrance to first open hall door): 82" (6' 10")
2. North Wall Space 2 (between open hall doors): 200" (16' 8")
3. Alcove: 24" (2')
4. West Wall Space 1 (from bathroom to fire extinguisher): 132" (11') Fire extinguisher height at 58"
5. West Wall Space 2 (fire extinguisher to corner): 48" (4')
6. East Wall Space: 102" (8' 6") - Currently work is not placed on this wall
