

On June 19, 2006, the Lamorinda Spirit Van Senior Transportation Program gave its first ride to two Chateau Lafayette older adults going to the C.C. Café now known as Café Costa. We have grown over the years, adding rides to grocery shopping, medical appointments, and errands when we gained our first volunteer drivers. After receiving a bequest from an appreciative passenger, we began subsidizing GoGoGrandparent Uber and Lyft rides for Lafayette residents, age 70+ in order to make it possible for Lafayette older adults to get out and about 24/7.

Our latest venture as we strive to help Lafayette become an Age-Friendly City is to provide a Lafayette Shopping Shuttle to drive a circuit up and down Mt. Diablo Blvd. taking people of all ages from store/business/restaurant to store/business/restaurant. The intent is



to make it easier for people to frequent Lafayette's downtown businesses while reducing traffic and parking congestion. Our search for a staff driver to pilot a weekly Shopping Shuttle from 10 am to 2 pm began in December 2021. As this additional service is increasingly used, we will be able to expand to 2+ days a week.




