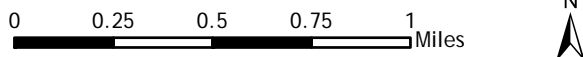


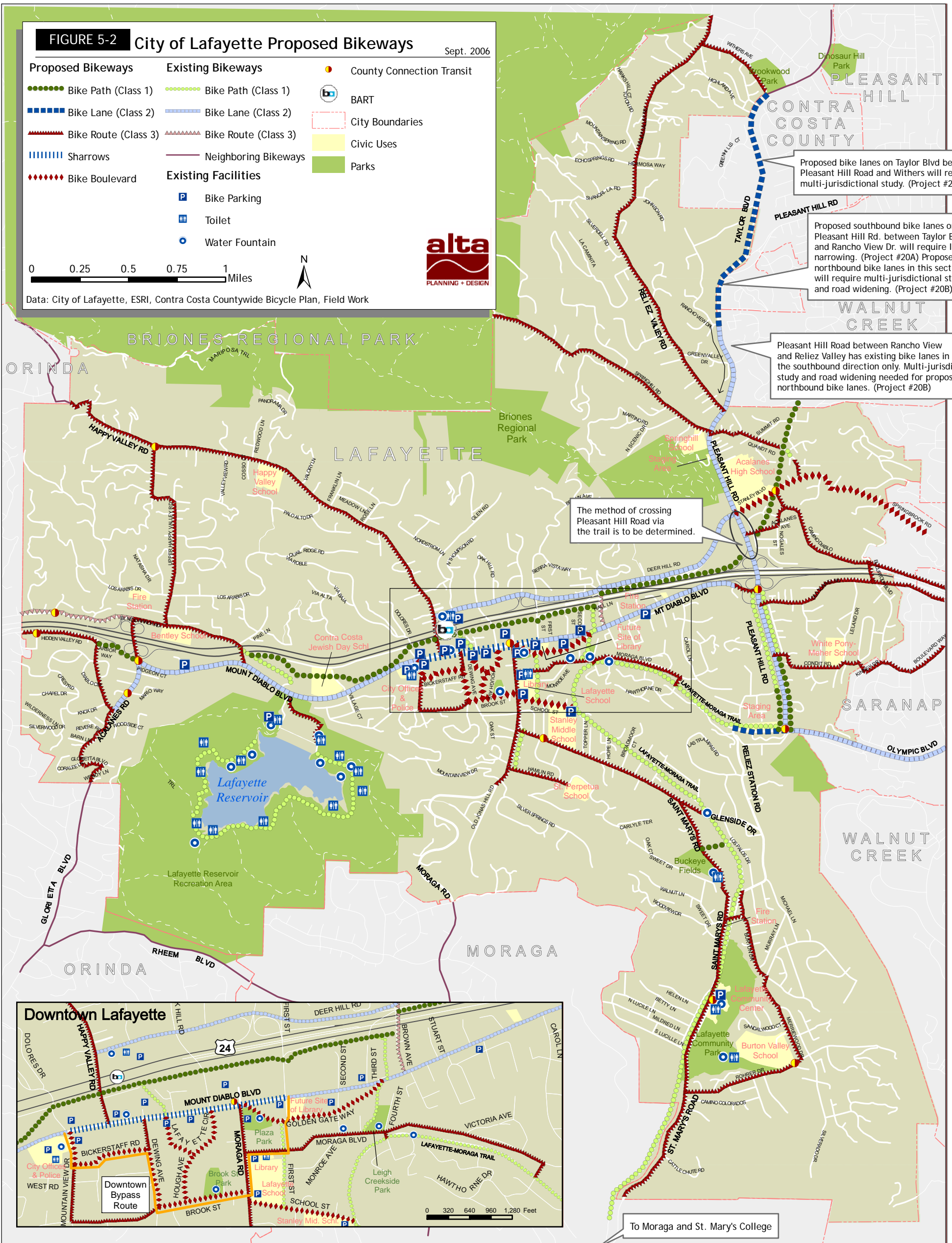
**FIGURE 5-2 City of Lafayette Proposed Bikeways**

Proposed bike lanes on Taylor Blvd between Pleasant Hill Rd and Withers will require multi-jurisdictional study. (Project #20A)

Proposed southbound bike lanes on Pleasant Hill Rd. between Taylor Blvd. and Rancho View Dr. will require lane narrowing. (Project #20A) Proposed northbound bike lanes in this section will require multi-jurisdictional study and road widening. (Project #20B)

Pleasant Hill Road between Rancho View and Reliez Valley has existing bike lanes in the southbound direction only. Multi-jurisdictional study and road widening needed for proposed northbound bike lanes. (Project #20B)

The method of crossing Pleasant Hill Road via the trail is to be determined.
